SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION

To impart science and technology education

STEP

- Run in rural and urban schools to teach students science through experimentation and learning models.
- STEP focuses on adequate understanding of principles and concepts of science.
- Equipment like laptops, projectors and microscopes are provided to schools to develop interest among the students for the subject.

KNOWLEDGE ON WHEELS

- Mobile science vans to reach the schools located in remote areas.
- The main focus is to make science and its experiential concepts accessible to the underprivileged students.
- The vans also have a library for school and community children.

COMMUNITY KNOWLEDGE HUB

- It is a 3000 square foot facility in Panvel, housing state-of-the-art Science labs for the underprivileged students.
- There are labs offered majorly for 5 subjects i.e. Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Robotics and Computer.
- Students of Raigad district and Navi Mumbai area are brought to the facility on a rotation basis.



FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

Provide support for higher and professional education for meritorious but financially challenged students

(A) Vidyarthi Vikas Yojana

- Vidyarthi Vikas Yojana provides students desiring to pursue higher education with financial support and ensure sustained education.
- It targets students in the society who have merit and capabilities but are not in a position to pursue higher education due to monetary issues.

(B) Book-Bank

- Under Book Bank, the students can borrow textbooks on returnable basis by paying a nominal deposit.
- In this program, books for engineering, medical and MBA courses are provided to enable students pursuing their graduation & post-graduation to avail resources and materials.

SMART COMMUNITY

Holistic development of Seva Vasti and villages

- Smart Community Project is a complement of Smart City Project that focuses on activities like school education, digital literacy, women empowerment, youth development, improved health, waste management and cleanliness in slum pockets of urban areas.
- Annadan project focuses on providing at least one meal for a group of people suffering from hunger and simultaneously imparting skills for earning livelihood with dignity.
- As a part of Rural Development, water conservation, self-employment, environment awareness, rain water harvesting, groundwater recharge through soak-pits, tree plantation and seed ball making & their distribution are the key activities.
- A model has been developed to give market linkages to farmers and self-help groups for products like cloth bags, spices etc.



SOCIAL LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Developing human resources and leaders in society

- With an aim to develop human resources and leaders in the social field, this project gives an opportunity to college students to work with the NGO for 10 days.
