❖ Sessions on Menstrual Awareness & Hygiene

Sr. No.	Activity	Attended By	Remark
1.	Session at Karvenagar Vasti on 10 th April 2022	Ladies working on Daily wages and as housemaids participated in the session.	53 ladies attended the session taken by Sonalitai Ghatpande. All the ladies carefully listened to the given information. Our Seva Sahayog volunteer Adititai Hatwalane also helped in the session. This session was arranged with the help of the RSB Foundation's Chetanji Kusalkar. They distributed Maitrin Sanitary Napkins for 6 months to these ladies.
2.	Session at Zilha Parishad School, Undri on 13 th April 2022.	School girls of 06 th and 09 th std participated in the session.	A total of 89 students & two teachers attended the session taken by Gouritai Pendse. Padmanidhi Mahila Sanghatana helped to arrange the session. After the session attendees gave their feedback on the same. Maitrin Sanitary Napkin Packets were distributed to all the students.

Gouritai also taught Red dot bags to slow learner students. Some of the students from the school also know to stitch and they were interested to learn to make Reusable cloth napkins also.





	An awareness session on menstruation and health under the Seva Sahayog Urmi project was conducted by Sonali Tai Ghatpande for the ladies of the self-help (Bachat gat) group of Rashtriya Sarvangin Vikas Sanstha at Shere Village near Mulshi Taluka. A total of 31 ladies were present for this session. We also taught them to make Red Dot bags and their importance. SSF Women Empowerment trainer Vidya Wavle trained the ladies to make Reusable Cloth Napkins. They will use this training to create employment and create awareness in their nearby villages. Ladies actively participated in all the activities. This event was organised by Shere Village Gram Panchayat, Madhavitai Bhakare & Poonamtai Mehta from Rashtriya Sarvangin Vikas Sanstha.

Our Urmi Volunteer Abha Dixit taught the girls to make red dot bags. The girls present for this session were given a one-year Maitrin Hygiene kit from Mespack Company. This the session was attended by Ushaji Subramanian, Neha Sharma, Samruddhi Gawankar, and Manisha Salamwade from the Mespack company.

Girls told us that they didn't get such in-depth scientific information from school or anywhere else and also sai that this information is very useful to them.

"We all experience menstruation every month but we don't have much information about it. Gouritai Pendse explained in a very simple way what was going on in our body, physical changes, and mental changes at the time of menstruation. Also got useful information about Red Dot Bags for disposable and we learned how to make these bags in a very short time."
