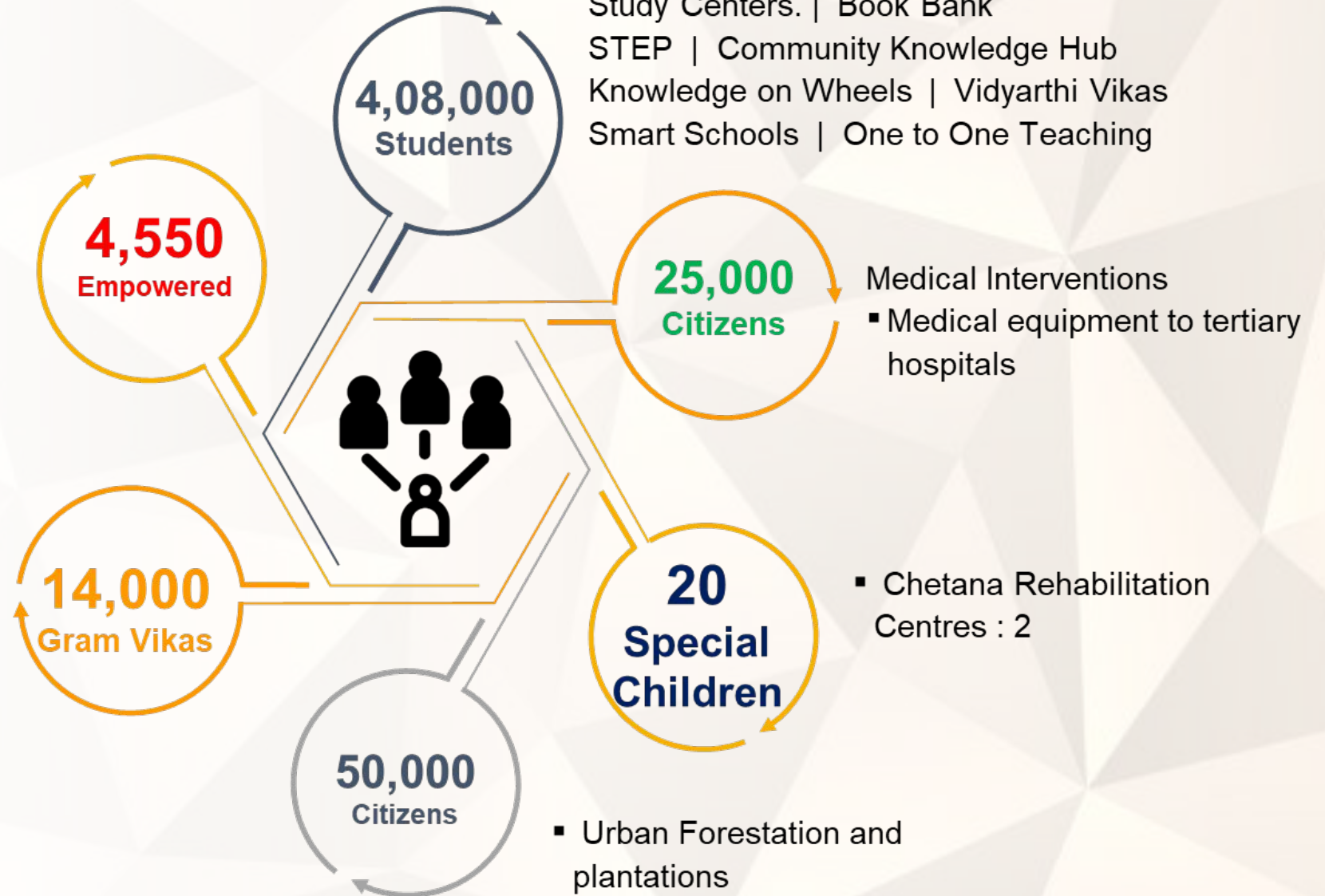

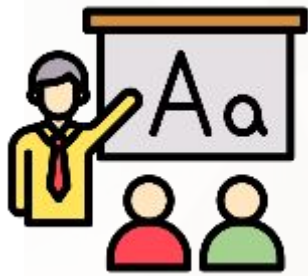

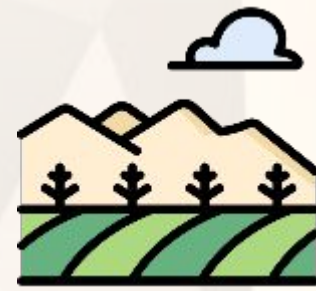

Mrs. Maneesha Joshi– A commerce graduate working as an independent accounting consultant

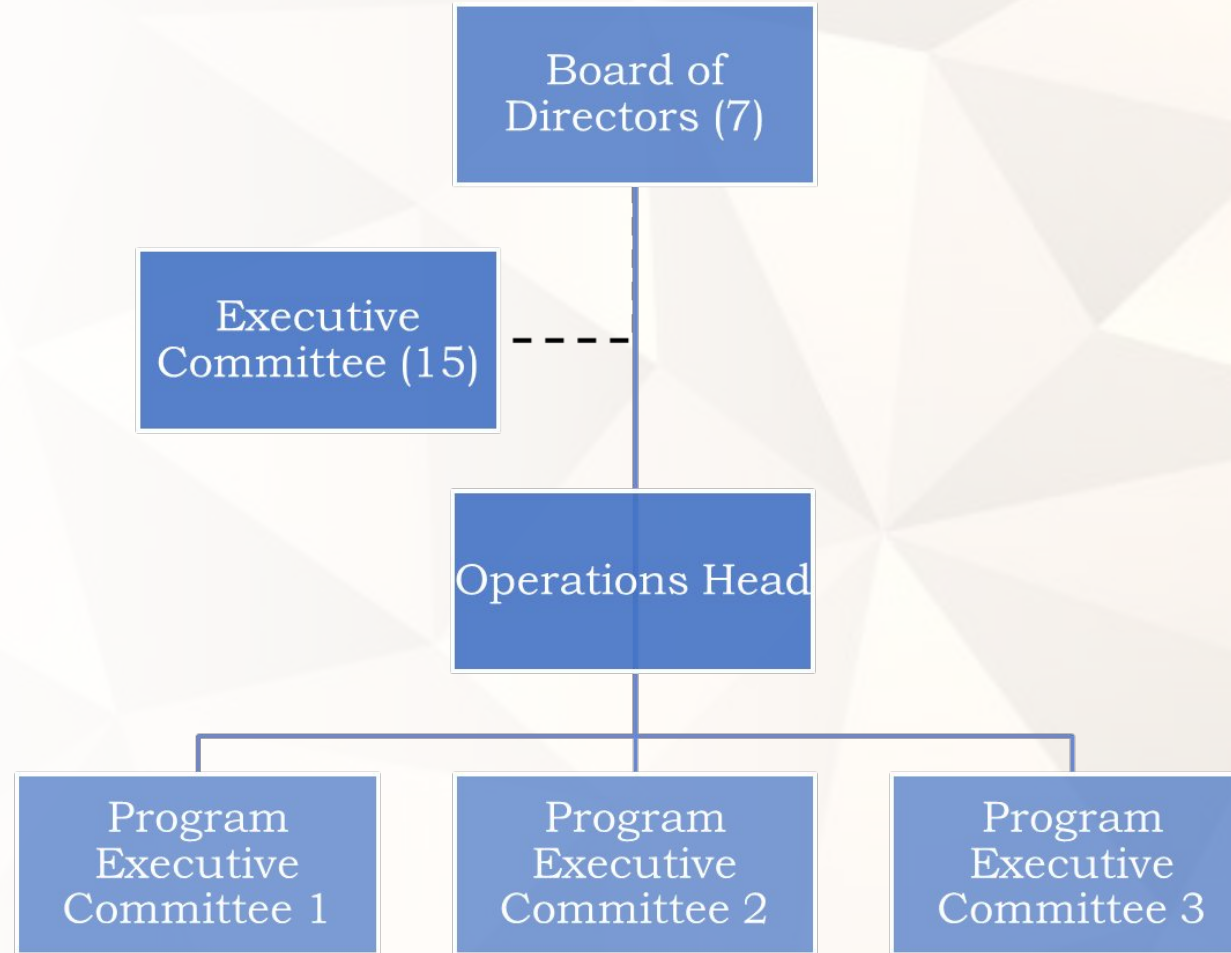

# Organizational Structure

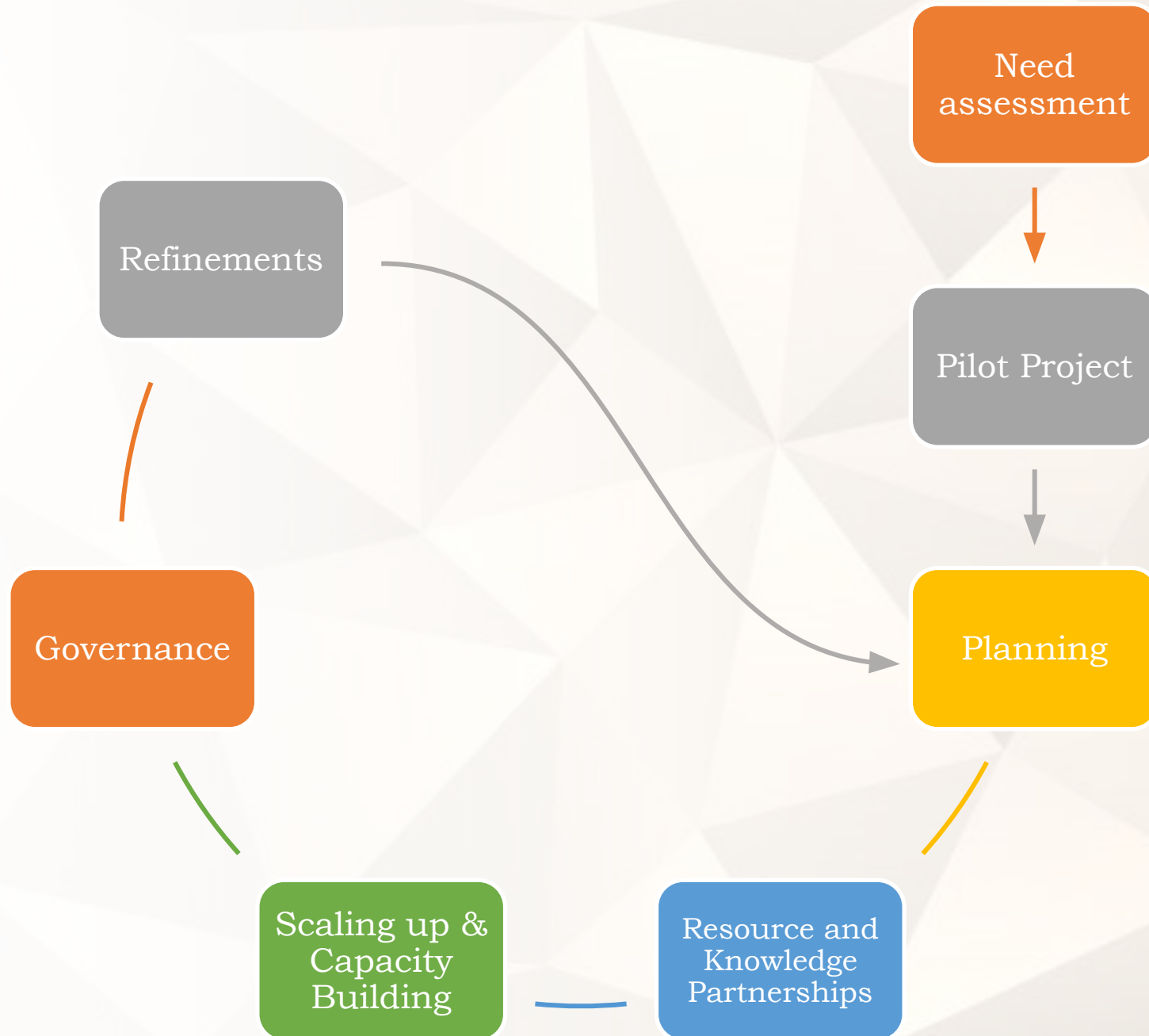


*Program Executive Committee = Executive Committee + Vertical Lead + Volunteer*
